

## Military Recruitment at Central College

The Career Center at Central College provides opportunities for students to explore and pursue a wide variety of career options. Among the opportunities afforded students are recruitment activities which include, but are not limited to: career fairs; on-campus interviews; information sessions; campus tabling; and advertising opportunities on bulletin boards or via on-line services.

We are compelled by federal law\* to allow the U.S. military to recruit on campus, or risk the loss of federal student financial aid funding. Also, because the military offers genuine career opportunities and blocking access to campus would unfairly limit students' access to these opportunities, the military is welcome to recruit at Central.

All military recruitment activities will be limited to career fairs and tabling at the Maytag Student Center. All recruitment dates and table arrangements will be coordinated by registering with the Career Center.
