While at Central, Ed and I met due to our alphabetical-order assigned seats in chapel!

I treasured the two opportunities I had to build community while living in group houses at Central: Firth Cottage (later torn down to make room for Scholte Hall) with 11 other sophomore women; and Pietenpol (Spanish) Spanish House as a junior with women of different ages and from different countries.

Sociology professor Walter Hopkins had a major influence on my years at Central and expanded my interest in sociology and social work. I was fortunate to work with him one summer in Des Moines on his juvenile justice system research project. It's hard to imagine now, gathering data manually from paper files!

Dr. Martin Luther King's visit to Central's campus in 1967 had a powerful impact on me. Living in the rural Midwest, it was easy to ignore the injustices that existed in our society. Dr. King's visit challenged me to pay attention and to be part of what needed to change.

My passion has been gardening, working (and sometimes struggling) to create beautiful outdoor spaces whatever the climate, from suburban Seattle, Denver, and New Jersey to my current compact city garden in Wilmington, Delaware.

With a smaller space to fill with plants, I now have time to volunteer in an inner-city preschool teaching about nature and helping with the children's garden. Inner-city living also gives me an opportunity to better understand the challenges people face and to get involved in work on policies that challenge injustice.

Singing has always been an important part of my life, in Central's A Cappella choir as well as church and community choirs. Recently, I've started singing in the Threshold Choir, a small women's group, offering bedside singing to comfort patients and families at Compassionate Care Hospice.

In between volunteer projects, Ed and I travel, both to visit family and to explore the world. It has been exciting to visit many of the places in the world we had always hoped to see in person. Traveling has sparked a new interest in world history. The challenge is trying to remember what I'm learning!

I was the first one from my immediate family to have the opportunity to go to college. I was also the eldest of three children and driven to be successful. I had wanted to go to Syracuse University and had a Regents Scholarship to defray some of the costs. I had been saving money from my paper route for years and quit the high school basketball team my senior year to work for more pay at an animal hospital. Fortunately, Syracuse was still too expensive and our pastor from Lisha Kill Reformed Church suggested Hope College where he had gone or Central as partial tuition support was provided by the reformed churches. I chose Central with the intention of transferring to Syracuse at a later date. The caring attitude of professors at Central as well as the comradeships and friendships that developed caused me to modify my goals.

My parents helped me my first year, but family resources were limited after my father had a severe heart attack at 43 when I was 12. I was able to play on the freshman basketball team my first year but realized I would not be able to continue participation in college sports and also make money needed to stay in school. I did sing in the Chapel Choir and I believe the Third Reformed Church in Pella my sophomore year. I was able to participate in intramural basketball and football for the remainder of my time at Central.

Given my financial challenges, many of my memories of life at Central were work-related. My jobs included phone duty, dorm counselor, moving chairs and tables for dances, serving breakfast and lunches in the cafeteria, secretary of the bowling league, washing dishes at a local restaurant, moving pianos and organs for a local music store, and working on road repairs and resurfacing in Pella. Summers were also hectic working as a sprinkler fitters helper days and at night at a drive-in theater. My experience at Central helped me to develop my independence and taught me that we can accomplish almost anything if we want it bad enough and work relentlessly to achieve it.

I wanted my own car but really could not afford it. I found six people who needed rides back to New York for Christmas break. I purchased a 1953 Ford for \$35 and contracted with those six people to take them round-trip to New York for \$35 each with the understanding that if the car did not make it, we would have to get alternative transportation to get home. The car made it home and back. The car was a "smoker" with a cloud of black smoke billowing out the back and the clutch did not work. I bought a case of oil and stopped every 100 miles or so to add oil and learned to shift the car without the clutch. One of my riders was so impressed with the car that he bought it from me for \$50 after we made it back to Central. I used the \$50 to buy a 1958 Ford. It was pretty rusted out and had holes over the headlights but it ran well. I took two old license plates and screwed them over the holes. It was ugly but effective. Unfortunately, about a year later the engine threw a rod through the piston. I towed the car to Lawrence Van Zante's garage. It was not worth fixing. He paid me for the rear end and a few other things and agreed to pay me something for scrap metal. He did

not care what the car looked like so I borrowed a sledgehammer from him, had some friends push the car to the student parking lot, and sold three sledgehammer hits at the car for a dollar. I also sold a headlight, the battery, and the good head off the engine. By the end of the day, I had \$85 for parts and hits at my \$50 car. I got four friends to hand push the car back to Lawrence's garage as the whole roof was caved in and I had a small area to see through and steer the car. I bought a 1957 Desoto with push button drive with the \$85.

I remember going to the store for some essentials after arriving at Central for my freshman year. I realized at check out that I had left my wallet in my dorm room. I was so embarrassed. I asked if I could leave my items under the counter until I could return with the money. They insisted that I take the items and just pay them the next time I came to town. I immediately went back to the dorm, got my wallet, and returned to the store to settle my debt.

I remember having my beanie stolen off my head at a store in town.

I remember marching to the President's house to protest and demand a day off to celebrate our football championship.

Last but not least, I remember Dr. Butler and Dr. Glendenning and their dedication to teaching and sage advice they provided me.

Who would have believed that Central College would have been my stepping stone to a successful career as an economist and that I would attain my ultimate positions as a senior policy advisor and chief economist for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, a 36,000 employee agency of the federal government?

Oh CUI oh CUI may your glory never die.
